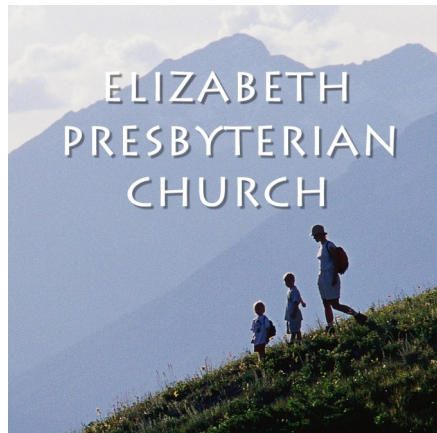
General Information

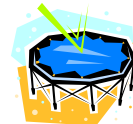
5th Quarter
